

'NURTURING THE YOUNG ONES'

For us the primary curriculum is the way in which we are going to develop a broad band of knowledge that exposes children to different ways of looking at the world. We aim to tailor education to individual need, interest and aptitude so as to fulfill every child's potential. Every child will have access to a rich, broad, balanced and differentiated curriculum. We will use diverse teaching strategies to develop the talents of each child and teachers will use the flexibilities that already exist to ally high standards in the basics with opportunities for enrichment and creativity.

The curriculum is broad, exciting and challenging: The curriculum embraces the five outcomes set out in Every Child Matters — Stay Safe, Be Healthy, Enjoy and Achieve, Achieve Economic Well-Being and Make a Positive Contribution; The curriculum is used to increase children's knowledge i.e. key concepts in mathematics, skills i.e. the ability to use the acquired knowledge, understanding as they grow and develop and become more aware of the world around them and fostering positive attitudes to the work they do at school. The curriculum will engage the children's interest, encourage and motivate them to want to learn; all children, regardless of gender, race or disability are given full access to our curriculum. Broad Guidelines

The Reception Year follows the Curriculum Guidance which includes six areas of learning:





Smart Interactive Classrooms

Smart Learning Classroom allows you to enable a personalized, secure and interactive learner experience to transform the learning experience and increase engagement thereby. It stimulates interactivity and collaboration while promoting creativity and learning across the curriculum.

♦ Science Lab

Our policy for science teaching is designed to develop the natural curiosity to be found in all young children and to teach them to approach a problem in a scientific way, which will involve them in developing key scientific skills. Hands-on, investigation-based science experiments are regularly planned into the curriculum.









Phonetics Lab

Phonetics is a part of the English language which helps to understand sounds of various alphabets. How an alphabet should sound is taught with the help of Phonetics. How a word should sound depends on our tongue movements, vocal cords, lip movements and even our breath. **Jolly Phonics** is a comprehensive program, based on the proven, fun and multisensory synthetic phonics method that gets children reading and writing from an early age. Each letter in Jolly Phonics sound as opposed to the alphabet. The 42 letter sounds are phonic building blocks that children, with the right tools, use to decode the English language. When reading a word, they recognize the letters and blend together the respective sounds; when writing a word they identify the sounds and write down the corresponding letters. The use of the Jolly Phonics program will give children a flying start with their reading, writing and spelling.

◆ Art & Craft Room

'Every child is an artist' - Picasso

Art & Craft is as essential as Sunshine. It is great for learners of all ages. The school has an art department that buzzes with creativity. From pre-school paper plate tambourines to fifth grade homemade thermometers, the Art & Craft activities fosters intellectual development, bilateral coordination, group play, developing fine motor skills, self expression and creativity. Our Art & Craft Room facility at DPPS provides children a variety of opportunities to explore the hidden artist.









Audio Visual Room

Audio Visual Room provides education to the children in a very enjoyable & pleasant environment. It includes many entertaining Movies for the children, Rhymes, Educational topics, Bal Geet & Moral stories etc. Subject PowerPoint presentations felicitate a child's imagination & his capacity to make various projects. It has a wide screen along with a projector and digital audio system. It is not only used by the students but by the teachers as well for in house workshops, guest lectures and seminars.

◆ Complete Air Conditioned Campus

The study aids provided for the students are as per the latest technological trends and environment with ventilated rooms and air cool facility.

Thinking if our children are given a way of learning that is engaging, innovative and creative, DPPS delightedly inculcates the curriculum of EDAC to make education more student-centric. The EDAC learning system makes learning a joyous, experiential and creative process which is a never ending upward spiral, a continuum, an acronym for the four-folded process bringing successful student outcomes through learning.







DPPS launches the use of a systematic teaching of phonics, grammar, spelling and punctuation; phonics program from session 2019–20. PHONICS is a technique for getting children off to a fresh start in mapping the relationships between letters and sounds and to give children a flying start with their: 'Learning the letter sounds, letter formation, Introduction to the main alternative spelling of vowels, Blending & Segmenting Tricky words.'

◆ SMART COURSES

We have collaborated with EBIX to make learning an exciting and enduring experience for the students. All the classrooms are equipped with Digital Smart Boards. Teachers at DPPS select the best combination of various approaches acting as facilitators and guide them in their learning using audio-visual stimuli, projects and presentations.









DPPS believes in wholesome development of each and every child and is a home to a vibrant community which celebrates and practices art in the form of Music, Dance and Arts which have been the key features of the school's comprehensive academic life blending culture and passion across a diverse creative landscape to develop the physical, mental and spiritual mind frame of the children.

EXPERT TEACHERS

FACILITIES

◆Teacher Student Ratio - The teacher student ratio is the most important part to focus on each and every child. We at our school maintain the ratio of 1:25 for playgroup & primary. It grants plenty of scope for individual attention to the students. Thus the teachers can nurture each student's emotional, behavioural and academic needs.

◆ CCTV Surveillance - The need of the hour is to ensure our children are safe and feel safe all the time. Vigilance and keeping an eye out for any anomaly or deviations in children's behaviour is something that we can all do to fortify ourselves. It can be used to keep track of attendance of students, teachers and support staff alike, along with ensuring they are all doing their work efficiently. It helps in keeping a watch on the teachers' methods of teaching and punctuality.

◆ School App - School application facilitates the parents with plenty much of options such as Attendance, Online notices & announcements, Events, Assignments, Student report card, Parent - Teacher live chat & many more.

◆ Spic Macay

It is a Society for the Promotion of Indian Classical Music and Culture amongst Youth. It is a non-political nationwide voluntary movement founded in 1977 by Dr. Kiran Seth. SPIC MACAY's intention is to enrich the quality of formal education by increasing awareness about different aspects of Indian heritage and inspiring the young mind to imbibe the values embedded in it.



An extensive programme of both educational visits and residential visits are arranged during school time to support and extend the children's learning. Such visits provide children with valuable first hand experiences. Parents are usually asked to make voluntary contributions to these activities. Visitors are encouraged. Actors, poets, theatre groups, artists and other experts are invited into school to broaden and enhance the children's learning.









LIFE AT DPPS

School House System

When children enter full-time school they will be allocated to one of the school's four houses – Earth, Air, Fire or Water.

Each house is vertically grouped across the school. Each house is led by a senior leader in school and each house will elect annually their House Captain and Vice House Captain. House assemblies take place weekly and quality work and representing your school in sport, music and drama is rewarded with house points. Inter-house sporting activities take place throughout the year culminating in our 'Battle of the Houses' Sports Day. The house with the most points at the end of the year wins the coveted House Trophy!





Reporting to Parents

There is an opportunity for discussion between parents and teachers at termly held parents' meetings. Curriculum Information meetings also take place throughout the year. Parents are encouraged to discuss any specific concerns they may have as they occur throughout the year with the class teacher. Written reports are sent to parents in the summer term. The reports always refer to attitude, effort and academic progress. If required the reports are supported by interviews between class teachers and parents.

Homework

Children are introduced to the idea of "work to be done at home" from an early age. Homework provides an opportunity for children to organise their own learning as well as activities that need support from parents/caretakers/guardians. It is important that children develop regular learning routines in preparation for secondary school. It is expected that they will spend increasing amounts of time on homework as they move.





◆ The Care of Children

All teaching and ancillary staff shares this responsibility with the Head Teacher. The welfare of each child is important to us all and close contact between home and school is the best way to make sure there is a clear understanding of the needs and progress of your child. It helps if parents inform the Head Teacher of any particular home circumstance which may affect the child's behaviour and attitude in school. It is important to inform school of a change of address, telephone number or place of contact.

◆ School Uniform

We believe that a uniform serves several important purposes:



It gives the pupils a sense of belonging



It helps to develop pride in their school



It is practical for parents as no more great debates about what to wear in the morning!

ADMISSIONS

Admission are open for the new academic session at DPPS Jodhpur. The school aspires to produce students who are excellent in academics as well as social and ethical values, skills and attitudes to contribute positively to the society.

◆ AGE CRITERIA

DELHI PUBLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL (A unit o DPS Pvt. Ltd.) admits children according to the circular, Directorate of Education (DoE) which has fixed an upper age limit of 4, 5 and 6 years as on March 31, 2020 for admission in Nursery, Kindergarten (KG) and Class 1, respectively. The minimum age for admission in these classes is 3, 4 and 5 years as of March 31, 2020 as recorded in the birth certificate will determine the eligibility for admission to a particular class respectively.

Whereas the school intakes admission for Playgroup at a minimum age of 2 years.

◆ REGISTRATION/ADMISSION PROCESS

Registration forms for Admission for the Academic Session 2020–21 will be available in the school office. The Registration Form should be duly filled in all respects. Parents are required to submit completed hard copy of Registration Form with documents and affixed recent passport size colour photographs of the candidate, parents on the Registration Form to school office along with Fees in cash/cheque. Admission Fee (One Time, only for new admission) and Annual fee shall be paid along with the 1 quarter Tuition Fee.

It is advised that parents should fill the Registration Form themselves to avoid any incomplete information, failing which the registration will be cancelled. Applying for registration / admission does not imply admission, which is subject to Observation cum Interaction / Assessment. It is also subject to the availability of seats.

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission:

- 1. ATTESTED PHOTOCOPY OF DATE OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE (Original to be brought for verification only)
- ATTESTED PHOTOCOPY OF PREVIOUS YEAR'S MARK SHEET
- 3. ORIGINAL SCHOOL LEAVING/TRANSFER CERTIFICATE
- 4. ATTESTED PHOTOCOPY OF RATION CARD/I CARD/ AADHAAR CARD (Child/Parent)
- 5. RECENT PHOTOGRAPH OF CHILD (4 in PP size)
- 6. RECENT PHOTOGRAPH OF PARENTS (2-2 each in PP size)

◆ OBSERVATION-CUM-INTERACTION FOR PRE PRIMARY CLASSES

Admission to classes Playgroup, Nursery, Kindergarten and Preparatory will be granted on the basis of the Observation-cum-Interaction. Presence of both the parents during this period is mandatory along with the child.

◆ ASSESSMENTAND INTERACTION SESSION FOR CLASS I ONWARDS

Class I onwards, an Assessment will be conducted which will be followed by an Interactive Session. Both the parents must be present in the School on the designated day. The entire procedure may last 1-2 hours. Parents are advised to plan their schedules accordingly.



OUR APPROACH TO LEARNING

We believe in the concept of lifelong learning and the idea that both adults and children learn new things every day. We maintain that learning should be a rewarding and enjoyable experience for everyone; it should be fun. Teaching should be about bringing out, not putting in. We aim to prepare children to be effective citizens of the future by:

- Enabling children to become confident, resourceful, enquiring and independent life-long learners
- Raising attainment through provision of high quality, challenging and engaging learning
- Personalising learning to ensure that each child can effectively develop their strengths
- Providing a broad and balanced curriculum that is both rewarding and enjoyable
- Developing skills, knowledge and understanding progressively, appropriate to individual needs
- Encouraging curiosity and risk taking
- Creating effective partnership between parents and the wider community to develop children's learning.

In line with our assessment policy, children play an active role in the marking of their work which informs staff about individual development, group attainment and future planning. Termly teacher assessments are made to closely track progress and attainment.

Curriculum Meetings and Information Evenings are held regularly to inform parents and

offer advice about how parents can support their child's learning at home.
